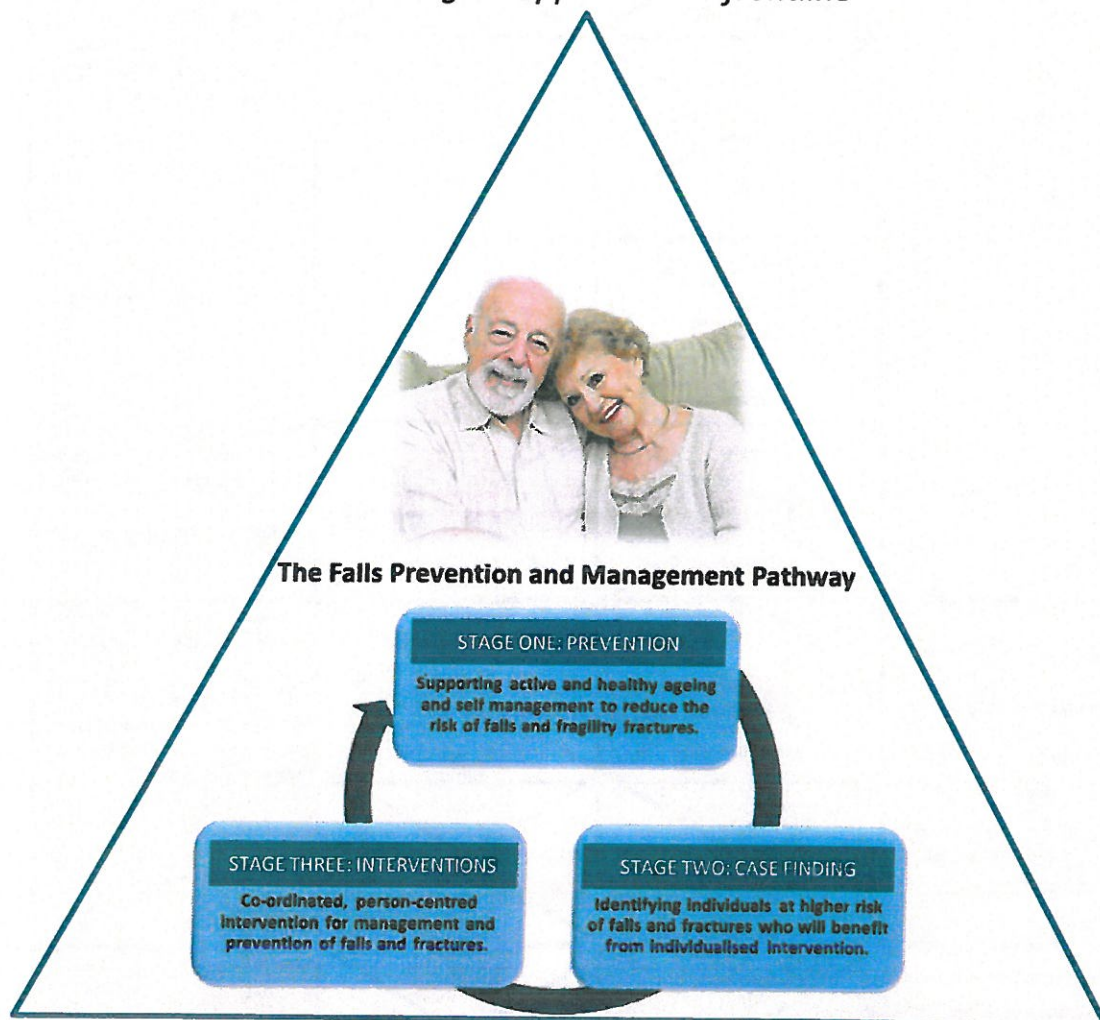

<p><b>Installation 2</b> September 2014-2015</p>		<p><b>Access-&gt; 30% of population 65 years &amp; older/ per Area</b></p> <p><b>Quality- Quality:</b> Provide correct assessment &amp; treatment after a first fracture to prevent a second using appropriate services in hospital and the community.</p> <p><b>Value</b> - reduce hip fractures by 20%</p>
<p><b>Installation 3</b> September 2015-2016</p>		<p><b>Access-&gt; 60% of population 65 years &amp; older/ per Area</b></p> <p><b>Quality-</b> Promote healthy lifestyles and reduce environmental hazards to reduce risk of falls &amp; fractures and improve quality of life.</p> <p><b>Value</b> - reduce ED activity related to falls and fractures by 20%</p>
<p><b>Installation 4</b> September 2016-2017</p>		<p><b>Access:</b> -&gt; 80% of population 65 years &amp; older/ per Area</p> <p><b>Quality:</b> Improve care &amp; quality of life for SU after hip fracture by ensuring an effective Integrated Care Pathway for a defined population is in place.</p> <p><b>Value:</b> Reduce nursing home admissions after harmful falls by 20%</p>
<p><b>Installation 5</b> September 2017-2018</p>		<p><b>Access:</b> -&gt; 100% of population 65 years &amp; older/ per Area</p> <p><b>Quality:</b> Ensure timely &amp; quality help from hospital &amp; community services both to enable SU to return to independent living and to prevent further falls &amp; fractures.</p> <p><b>Value:</b> Quantify integrated process and outcome measure savings</p>
