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Terms of Reference:

- To formulate and implement action plans to reduce the number of falls and increase bone health in the population of over 65ys,
- To audit and/or review existing levels of Falls prevention and Bone Health services across all health and social care settings, such as acute hospital, primary care and long terms residential care settings,
- To establish baseline quantum of services per region,
- To select pilot sites for implementation of the action plans per HSE Region,
- To establish criteria and initiatives for national implementation
- To oversee and evaluate these pilots using key performance indicators
- To undertake/continue consultation with relevant key stakeholders
- To develop a national implementation plan based on agreed recommendations, responsible person(s), timeframes and outcomes.
- Will inform and report to the National Sponsorship Team who will advise, steer, oversee, monitor and enable the work of the NIT.

TOR and Membership of the National Implementation Team will be reviewed annually,

A three year timeline for implementation (2013-2015) will be drafted to help focus the work and will be reviewed annually and amended accordingly.

NIT will meet every second month but at minimum thrice yearly

A quorum of a minimum of 6 members (50%) of the team need to be in attendance in order to hold a meeting,.

Will submit an annual report to the National Sponsorship Team
